1. Call to Order at 3 pm (In attendance: Gina & Michelle)
2. Review Norms – Norms are posted.
3. Approval of March 7, 2019 Minutes (Proxy vote went out, as not enough members were in attendance to approve.)
4. Report out on any DAC/DELAC meetings attended to date:
  - 3/13 DAC – Internet Security ~ Consolidated Application @ the District Office; Gina reported out. The Con App. Monitors Free & Reduced lunch #s. Federal vs. State funds – local decision making. Cedar Grove and Cadwallader are now entering into Title status. They are targeted for planning (needs assessment for funds, qualifier is greater than 40% of the students on free and reduced lunch.) School wide versus targeted is different. Internet Security wasn't discussed even though it was on the calendar. Dan talked about what information can be found on our district's dashboard. API was just a number, but the dashboard looks at a bigger picture. It's a place to get more information (Academics, Suspension rate, culture/climate, and truancy.) Chronic absenteeism is 10% of school days missed, which equals 18 days/year. Science is not on there yet. You can look at student groups and sib groups in detail. Youthtruth data is desegregated by ethnicity. Formulas are complex – They look at the distance from where they are and where they need to be, and where they are from where they were to measure growth. We looked at the overall lack of progress of our EL subgroup and Dan/Denise talked a little about our instructional program and difference between Integrated and Designated ELD. Integrated ELD is access to content and Designated ELD is specific language instruction.
  - 3/27 DELAC – ELPAC ~ Cyber Safety/"Social Media" @ Katherine Smith; Gina reported out. Denise and Connie shared with those in attendance the ELPAC (English Language Proficiency Assessment for California) and understanding your student's scores. This assessment replaced the CELDT. There are practice tests on-line. Denise went over Reclassification guidelines and the criteria from kinder through 8<sup>th</sup> grade (Overall ELPAC scores of level 4, local assessments, such as

BPST-Basic Phonics Skills Test, SOLOM-Student Oral Language Observation Matrix, parent consultation, teacher input, AR tests, and Writing Assessments.) Denise talked about the upcoming Tech Expo at JFS. Then 2 teachers in the district, Mae Valentino-Picket and Aura Monge presented on Cyber Safety & Social Media. A lot of great handouts and resources were given out such as; Electronic Do's & Don'ts, and age appropriate learning systems, such as Leap Frog & Kidi Buzz & getting Internet smart. Group conversation was had about what we do as teachers and parents to shield our students. We did a turn and talk with our table group on different questions pertaining to cyber safety and social media. Kids can create "ghost" accounts where parents can see. There are ways to monitor your child's account remotely if it's link to your phone. We pay the phone bill and hold the access. Parents are their child's first teacher. Common sense media is a great resource beyond tech, apps, but also movies, TV shows and books.
