## Path to UC/CSU Admissions The Requirements

- Subject
- a-g Courses
- GPA
- Grades
- Examination
- SAT/ACT

- Personal Insight Questions
- Only for UC; not for CSU

a. History
- 2 years minimum
b. English
- 4 years minimum
c. Mathematics
- 3 years minimum
- 4 years Recommended
- Starting with Algebra
- UC only; seat time in Geometry
d. Lab Science
- 2 years minimum
e. Language other than English
- 2 years minimum
f. Visual/Performing Art
- 1 year required
g. College Prep Electives
- 1 year required


## GPA Requirement "Grades"

- For UC eligibility, students must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA and competitive is at least a 3.6 GPA.
- For CSU eligibility, students must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and competitive is at least a 3.0 GPA.
- Can earn extra points in Honor \& AP Courses
- Calculated with grades in a-g courses from the summer after $9^{\text {th }}$ grade until the summer after $11^{\text {th }}$ grade


## Examination Requirement

- 3 Hour Exams
- SAT or ACT
- UC requires:
- SAT with Essay
- ACT with Writing
- Required score can depend on:
- GPA
- College or major you are applying to
- PSAT is a practice exam
- It is important for students to take the PSAT their junior year in order to be
 considered for the National Merit Scholarship
